## Association Membership

11.0 Types of Members

11.1 Membership may comprise different classes of membership as decided by the Association.

11.2 Members have the rights and responsibilities set out in these Rules. 12.0 Admission of Members

12.1 To become a Member, a person ("the Applicant") must: a. Full Member: Have been on the posted strength of a Special Air Service unit for a period in excess of 28 days if before 1 January 1990 or in excess of 90 days if after 1 January 1990.

b. Associate Member: Be a widow/widower, surviving partner or immediate kin (in the case of a deceased single Member) of a person who, at the time of his/her death, was eligible for full membership. c. Honorary Member: In exceptional cases where an applicant does not meet the requirement of 12.1.a/b an individual may be nominated by the Committee to a panel comprising the Patron, Chair/President and both the Colonel Commandant and Commanding Officer of the New Zealand Special Air Service Regiment who must unanimously decide on the individuals membership.

12.2 Applicants are to apply in writing to the Committee who may request additional information from the Applicant and who also may interview the Applicant.12.3 The Committee shall have complete discretion when it decides whether or not to allow the Applicant to become a Member. The Committee shall advise the applicant of its decision, and that decision shall be final.
